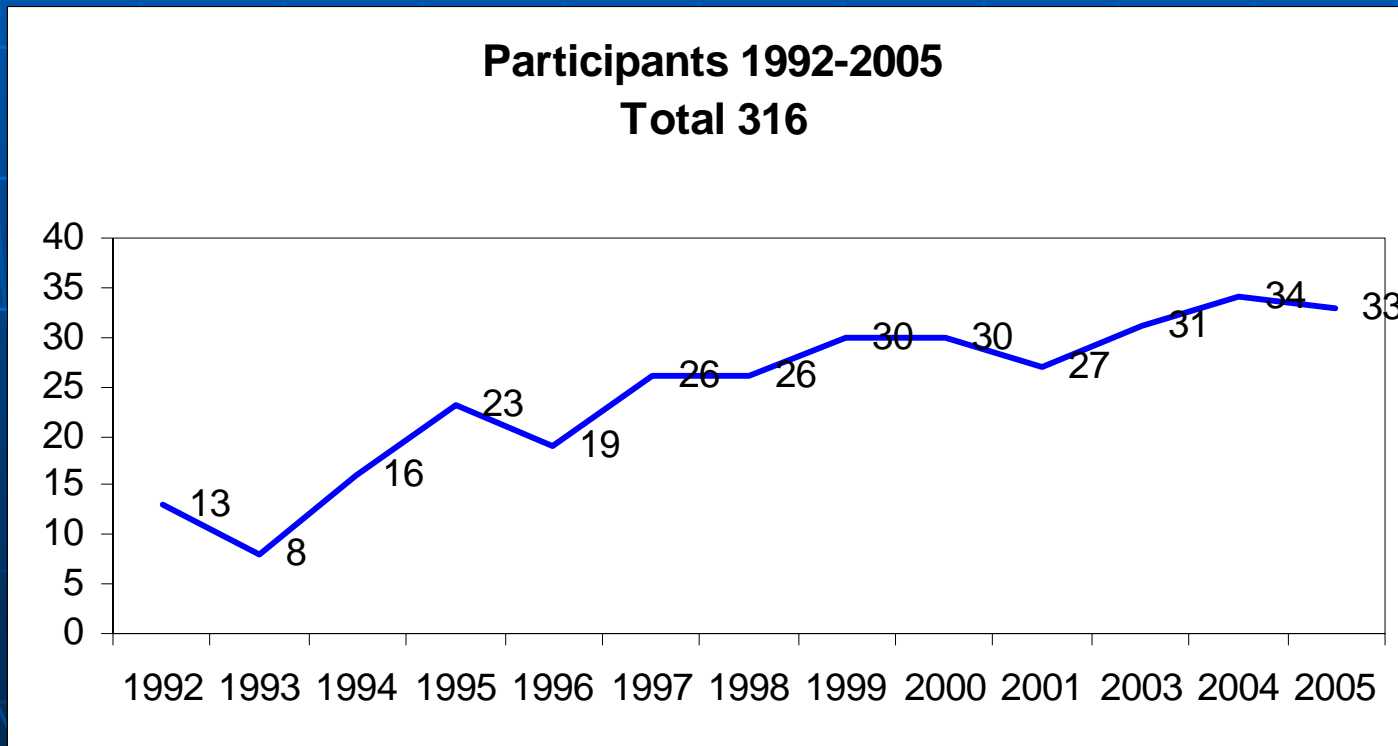

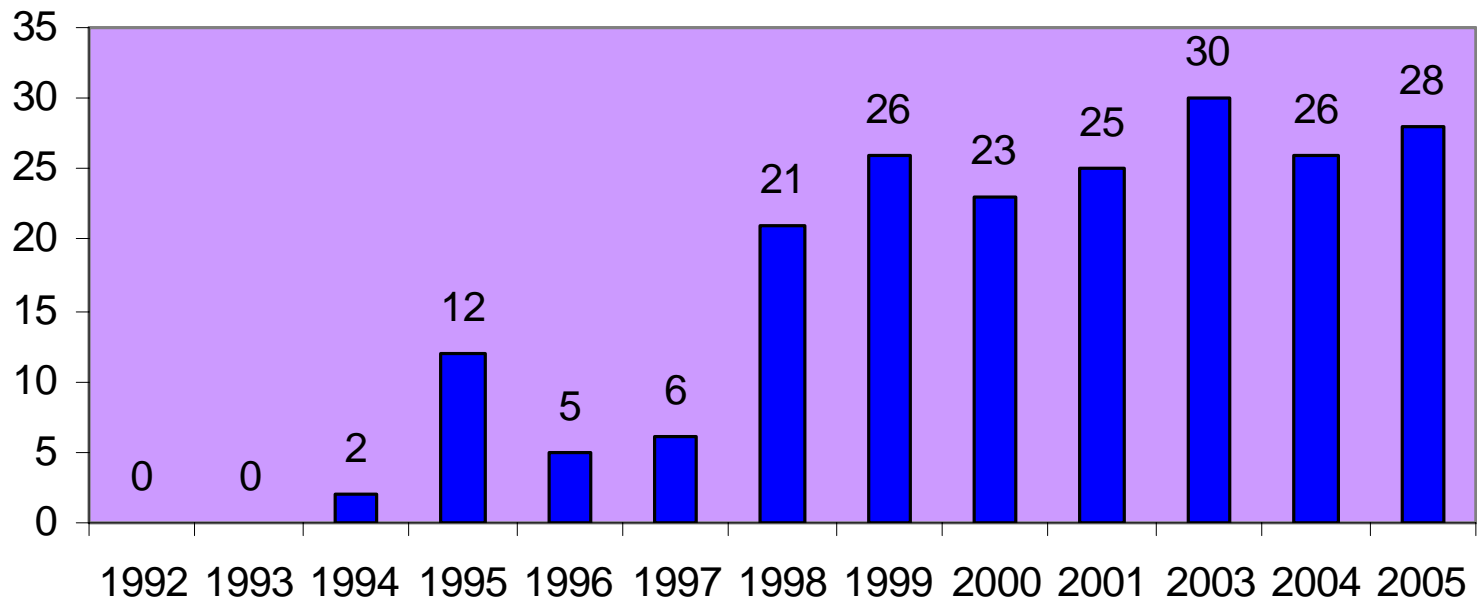

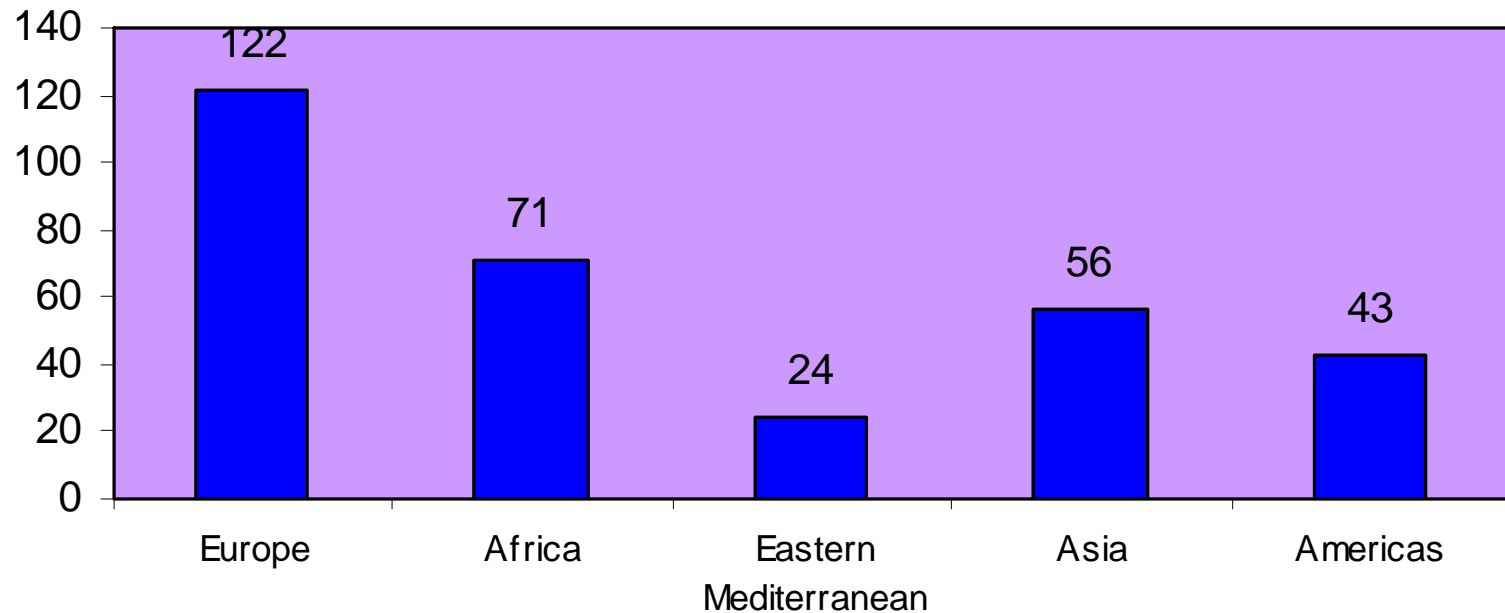

**Participants with Study Grant 1992-2005**



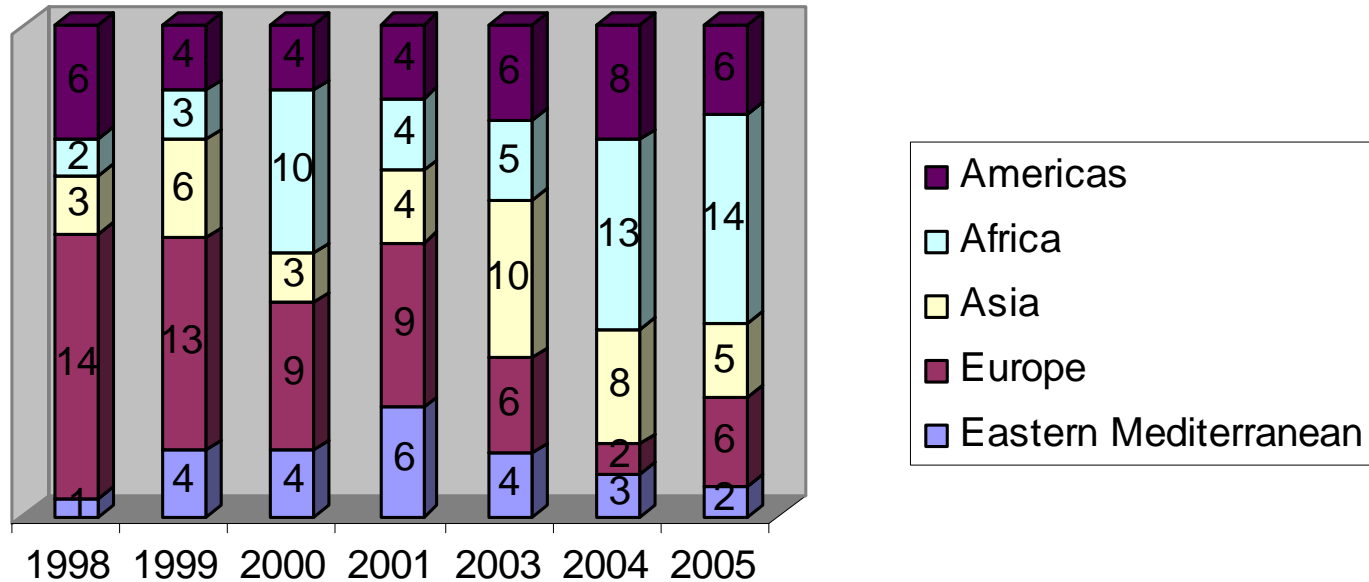

**Participants/region 1992-2005**



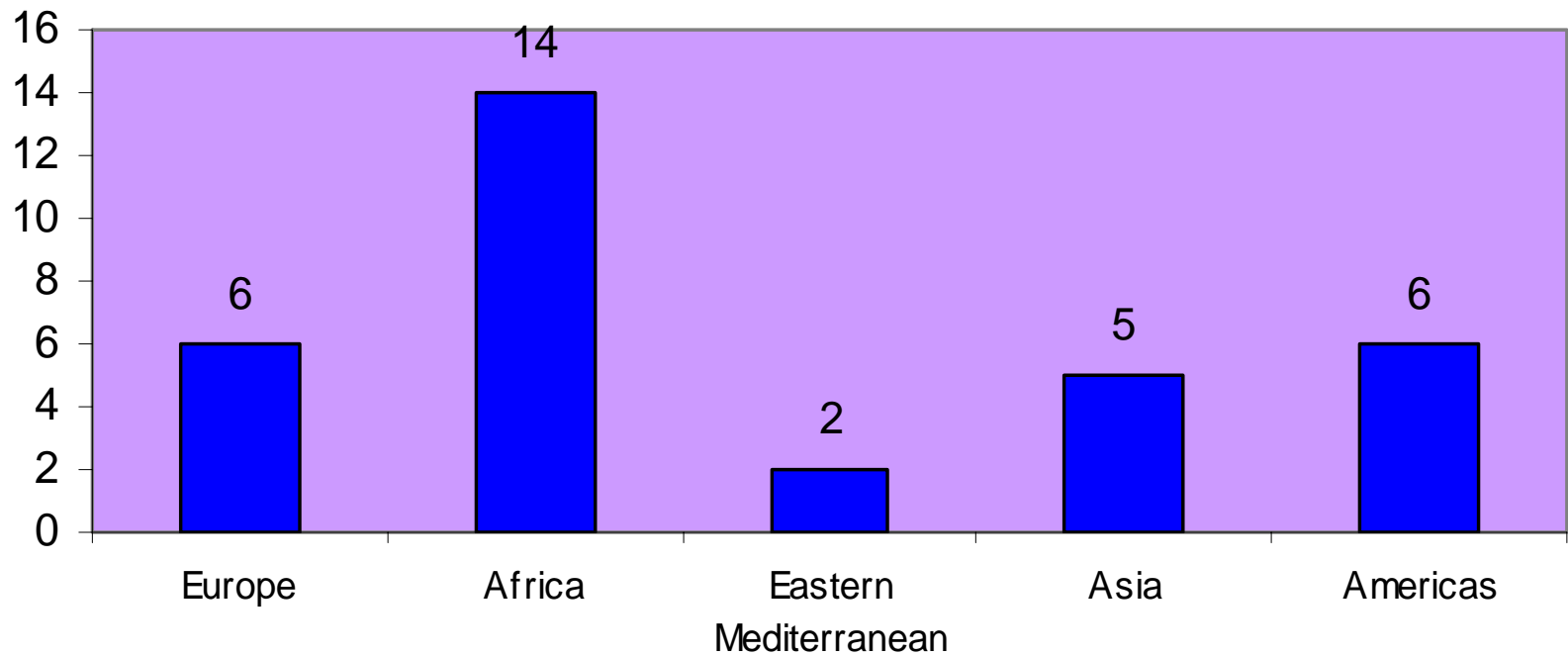

Participants/region/year 1998-2005



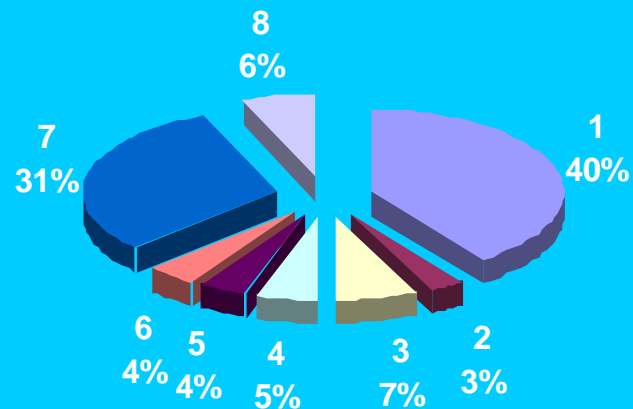
