Specific learning outcomes (1)

Specific learning outcomes (2)

4. Improved skills on key aspects of person centered care on:

- Communication for FGM prevention
- Management of FGM complications
- 5. Better awareness of the legal and accountability measures to stop FGM and its medicalization
- 6. Improved skills to develop plans that are informed by setting and needs
